**2pm:** Arrive at Ludgvan Church Hall. Refreshments and presentation This is an accessible venue.

**4pm:** Depart for St Michael's Mount

**5pm:** approx time of arrival at the Mount

Join Cornwall Faith Forum, Friends of St Michael's Way and others for a group walk for Peace along the St Michael's Way. Launching a small companion booklet by artist Janet McEwan with contributions from others, offering many views and understandings of the St Michael's Way footpath and pilgrimage.

**Parking:** There is limited street parking at Lelant, car parks at Carbis Bay and Lelant Park and Ride and small car parks at Trencrom and Ludgvan.

**Transport:** Limited transport will be available through booking on [www.crbo.co.uk](http://www.crbo.co.uk). Minibuses will take passengers from Ludgvan to Lelant or later from Marazion to Lelant. *St Michael's Way is 12.9 miles in length. Please ensure that you are fit enough to walk the distance and wear sturdy footwear. **All walkers walk at their own risk.***

*If the walk is cancelled due to bad weather and/or poor ground conditions this will be notified via the website. Bring your own packed lunch. **Sorry no dogs.***
