(The Diocese of Truro Safeguarding Officer Sarah Acraman has agreed to act as the CFF Safeguarding Independent Adviser and Rosey Sanders CFF Adminstrator has a lot of experience of the Policy)

Dioceses of the Church of England now have to follow the national C of E Policy and not have their own.

Trustees agreed unanimlously to adopt this Policy as our Guiding Document
