Safeguarding Policy for Adoption

The documents of a revised CFF Safeguarding Policy had been circulated prior to the meeting. CFF had based their policy on that held by Diocese of Truro. (The Diocese of Truro Safeguarding Officer Sarah Acraman has agreed to act as the CFF Safeguarding Independent Adviser and Rosey Sanders CFF Administrator has a lot of experience of the Policy)

Dioceses of the Church of England now have to follow the national C of E Policy and not have their own.

Trustees agreed unanimously to adopt this Policy as our Guiding Document
